

Tasting Notes

With lovely coloration our 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon shimmers like a fine ruby. The nose is incredibly inviting with warm aromas of ripe raspberries, graphite and savory smoked meat. On palate look for notes of herb garden, black cherries, red currant, and creamy vanilla. Fruit expression and earthy richness complement each other for a beautifully expressive and delicious red wine. Tannins and acidity are in balance for a fine wine today and cellaring potential for years to come. Notice the harmonious finish that leaves mouthwatering flavors that linger. We recommend pairing our 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon with filet mignon, bison, lamb and mushroom-ragu sauces.
