Inviting aromas and flavors of black plum, sweet smoke notes and dried figs predominate. Enjoy the gorgeous integration of wild juicy berries, fine leather, and vanilla, Tannins are smooth while medium-minus acidity creates harmonious balance and lend to the incredible structure of this barrel and bottle aged wine. All elements of the wine lend to a rich red wine that is enjoyable today and with plenty of life to age well for years to come. Enjoy our 2019 Tempranillo on its own and with savory flavors of roasts, lamb chops, and game meats. Grilled portabella mushrooms are great companions, especially when accented with a smoked or aged cheese. Cheers!
