Aromas and flavors of white peach, glazed citrus, graphite and honeycomb create the luscious character of the 2021 Sauvignon Blanc Barrel Select. Our winemaker identified and selected three French barrels that exhibited special qualities of Sauvignon Blanc to create this fresh and graceful dry white wine. Aged sur lie for a year brought forth texture and complexity to make our 2021 Sauvignon Blanc Barrel Select a standout. Heavenly paired with lighter seafood fare or with a cream sauce. Best when enjoyed slightly chilled.
